Results of the recent TestDaf-Exam in Jena (T 008)

There were 25 examinees who took part in the most recent TestDaF-Exam in Jena. The analyses of the test results show that more emphasis has to be put on reading and writing, as this is where the examinees proved to have difficulties. The oral results were sufficient.

Results of the recent TestDaf-Exam in Ansbach Z 0008 (2003-06-26)

The test results were available to the students 6 ½ weeks after the exam was taken. The best results were achieved in writing, with some students managing top marks. More emphasis has to be put on reading and listening, as this is where the examinees proved to have difficulties. The

preparatory courses will put focus on the improvement of those abilities which were least sufficient in the past exam.

The average marks for the single parts of the exam were:

Reading: 2, 9 points
Listening: 3, 1 points
Writing: 3, 9 points
Speaking: 3, 3 points

According to the achieved results one candidate may apply for a place in law, social or business studies. 50% of the candidates could now apply to study computer sciences, engineering, mathematics, arts and music and natural sciences.
