## 6. News from the Fachhochschule Ansbach and the Institut für Interkulturelle Kommunikation e.V.

- A delegation from Shandong University of Science and Technology visited the Fachhochschule Ansbach from 29/05/2003 to 02/06/2003 to discuss the widening of the cooperation between the institutions. Members of the Chinese delegation were the Vice-chancellor of the Shandong University, Prof Wang Mingzhen, the Head of the Department of Management and Business Administration, Prof Wang Xinhua and Prof Yang Fengjie. As a result of the talks an agreement was signed to develop students exchange programmes. Part of the exchange is the improvement of language Skills of the students to enable them to meet the requirement of entering a German university. In practise the students will take palce in a language preparatory course in China (min. 800 hours German) and then go to Ansbach to take part in a language course in preparation of the DSH. The language course in germany will be held with the of the IIK e.V. Ansvach and Prof Dr Dr G. Wazel, the head of the DSH exam committee of the FH Ansbach. After the successful passing of the DSH the student might take up a gegree cours in business administration or engineering.
- On 07.05.03 the IIK e.V. has elected a new chairmen and advisory committee. Wulf Schroeder a member of the IIKe.V. from the very beginning ist he new chairman and head of the IIK e.V.
